RICE RALLY

What will happen at the event?

There are over 50 youth groups and ISCF groups attending each year. There are pre-event activities, a congregational game, lots of music worship, and most importantly, a Bible-based evangelical talk preaching Jesus as our Lord and Saviour. There will also be a time for youth to respond and reflect on what they've experienced and heard at the event.

TICKETING

Can I buy tickets online?

Yes. You can buy tickets [here](#) up until Wednesday 3rd August at midnight.

Can I buy tickets at the door?

Yes. There will be a box office at the door from 2pm. Tickets will sell for \$32. Cash only, subject to availability.

RESERVED GROUP SEATING

Is there reserved group seating?

Yes.

How do I apply for reserved group seating?

You will be able to apply by clicking 'yes' when ordering tickets

What if our numbers change for reserved group seating?

We do not want to discourage anyone to continue to invite their friends to Rally after they have provided their numbers to RICE Rally. Please let us know if your numbers change by emailing tickets@riceevent.org.au.

Which seats will my group get for reserved group seating?

Our Facebook page will post up an image of which seats are available for group seating. After you register, we will let the groups know the approximate area you will be seated. However, because group sizes are not final, we may have to relocate your group elsewhere so please keep that in mind. On the day of Rally, an usher will show your group to your seats. To ensure smooth running of the night, we will have to ask for your whole group to arrive at Rally before doors open.

Please note for reserved group seating:

- We can only organize reserved seating for groups larger than 20 people
- To ensure that we are fair on smaller groups and to retain the atmosphere, we will not be allocating the best seats for group seating.

MERCHANDISE

Will there be merchandise this year?

Yes.

Can I buy this before RICE Rally?

Yes. We will release a form to sign up for presale merchandise, after which you will be able to pay by direct transfer and then pick up your order at Rally (upon confirmation of payment).

PARKING & GETTING THERE

Where can I be dropped off/picked up?

If you are getting dropped off, please get dropped off on Olympic Blvd outside Sydney Olympic Park Sports Centre. Ushers will guide you through the whole process as you approach the roundabout at the end of the road.

If you are getting picked up, there is free 30 minute parking at the venue in the outside carpark. Just enter at Davy Road or Central Road. We ask parents to consider arriving from 7:00PM. We will have ushers around to direct them.

If you wish to drive, there is parking available in P3 for \$5 an hour or \$25 per day

Where can I park?

What will happen when I take the train?

If you are taking the train, Sydney Olympic Park train station is a 10 minute walk away. There will be ushers along this recommended route to guide you to the venue, and also after the event.

What will happen if I take the bus?

The Park is serviced by 5 bus routes, including the 401, 450, 525, 526 and 533.

OTHER

Will there be dinner?

There will be no food or drinks provided on the night. We recommend that you utilise the time after Rally to have dinner with your youth group and discuss what they've just heard and experienced at Rally. The night will end at about 7:30pm.

How safe is the venue at night?

We endeavour to make the event as safe as possible.

- There will be a first-aid station for the duration of Rally
- There will be security guards provided by the venue at the main entrance of the event, and inside the venue
- RICE Rally volunteers will be lined along the path to the train station for the main arrival and departure of attendees, before and after Rally.
